3 **SECTION 1. SHORT TITLE.**

4 This Act may be cited as the “NICS Review Act of  
5 2021”.

6 **SEC. 2. REQUIREMENT THAT NICS RECORDS BE RETAINED**

7 **FOR AT LEAST 90 DAYS.**

9 Further Continuing Appropriations Act, 2012 (34 U.S.C.

1 40901 note; Public Law 112–55; 125 Stat. 632) is amend-  
2 ed by striking “no more than 24 hours” and inserting “no  
3 fewer than 90 days”.
